BACKGROUND:

In accordance with Iowa Code Chapter 281-95.1, school districts are required to take specific steps to accomplish the goals of equal employment opportunity and affirmative action in the recruitment, appointment, assignment and advancement of personnel.

The district continues to be committed to hiring and retaining a diverse staff and providing a welcoming, culturally responsive learning and work environment.

Employment data over the past two years reflects increases in the employment of minorities in the following employee groups: central office administrators, assistant principals and other professionals. Numbers remained constant for principals, teachers, counselors and overall employment.

Proposed strategies reflect efforts to increase hiring and retention through aggressive targeted recruitment efforts, grow-your-own initiatives, and equity related training.

BACKGROUND:

The district continues its commitment to hiring and retaining a diverse staff and providing a welcoming, culturally responsive learning and work environment.

To inform and enhance our efforts to recruit and retain minority educators, certified minority employees were invited to participate in focus groups. Participants provided feedback through small group "stay" conversations.

This feedback was reviewed, summarized and "unpacked" with district administrators by consultants from The Creative Corridor Center for Equity (C3E) and West Wind Education Policy as part of their program to support the recruitment and retention of staff of color in partnering school districts. The Waterloo Community School District entered into an agreement with C3E to collaborate with each other and with other school districts in the region. Currently, Cedar Rapids, Iowa City and Waterloo remain active in this collaboration.

To further advance this initiative, C3E invited researchers from Drexel University to conduct a study to investigate the experience of minority educators in schools and communities in the Corridor. They conducted focus groups of current teachers of color to determine why they stay and what challenges threaten their willingness or ability to do so.

Dr. Kristine Grant of Drexel and Circe Stumbo of C3E will present their findings and potential implications for Waterloo.

BACKGROUND:

The School Resource Officers Agreement is a cooperative agreement between the Waterloo Community School District and the City of Evansdale. The School Resource Officer Program provides for the assignment of one police officer for the Evansdale schools. Primary assignment is at the middle school level with the Resource Officer providing additional services at the elementary level. The School Resource Officer assists the schools in providing a safe and orderly environment through the introduction and presentation of the substance abuse and violence awareness programs.

The total cost of \$31,249.50 is the same as the current agreement and is due in two installments (November 1, 2018 and April 1, 2019).

THE SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION IS:

BACKGROUND:

This agreement with Cedar Valley Promise Empowerment is an amendment of the original contract with Cedar Valley Promise to provide school ready funding within the district as described below:

Sponsorship of six early childhood four year old placements at a cost of \$23.75 per child per day for a total request of \$37,049. The contract allows purchasing six placements for children who currently cannot access early childhood education because of the income level of their family. This contract is hereby extended from August 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019.

Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law

BACKGROUND:

Ms. Holley Miller, mother of students, NiAirea Miller and JaNiyah Miller, who are students at Lincoln Elementary School with NiAirea Miller going into the fourth grade for the 2018/2019 school year, and JaNiyah going into third grade for the 2018/2019 school year. Ms. Miller made application to open enroll her children into the Cedar Falls School District. This open enrollment was not timely received, but was based on the additional reason of pervasive harassment.

The Superintendent denied the application as set out in Superintendent's Exhibit #3 of the Waterloo Community School District's exhibits based upon the fact that Student Services investigated the claim and determined that the situation does not provide for an exception to the normal Open Enrollment Rules.

Ms. Miller filed an appeal of the Superintendent's decision. On June 25, 2018, a hearing was held in this matter before the undersigned Hearing Officer Timothy J. Luce. Appearing on behalf of the students was Holley Miller, the student's mother. The Waterloo Community School District was represented by Steven Weidner, their attorney, Tara Thomas, Director of School and Community Relations, Superintendent Dr. Jane Lindaman, Linda Armstrong, Secretary and Brad Schweppe, Lincoln principal, and Ms. Stevenson, lead teacher, Lincoln Elementary School.

During the hearing, testimony was received from Tara Thomas, Director of School and Community Relations, Dr. Jane Lindaman, Brad Schweppe, Ms. Stevenson, and Holley Miller, parent of the students.

The testimony provided by Ms. Miller surrounded incidents regarding both of her children. Exhibit 8 was presented by Ms. Miller which set forth in detail the incidents that she felt should have resulted in the children being allowed to be open enrolled as to pervasive harassment. Exhibit 8 was admitted into evidence. The incident regarding JaNiyah involved a teacher placing hands on the shoulder close to the neck area. This was investigated and was not found to be an inappropriate situation by the Waterloo Schools. The main incident regarding NiAirea was involving threats being made by a student that had had been in a previous altercation with NiAirea. This also was investigated by the Waterloo Schools and the Administration felt that this matter had been dealt with in an appropriate manner.

The Waterloo Community School District provided Exhibits 1 through 7 and Ms. Miller provided Exhibit 8, all of which were admitted by the Hearing Officer.

After careful consideration of the evidence presented at the hearing and with the review of Exhibit 8, the hearing officer believes that the Board should accept the attached Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law which will, if approved, uphold the Superintendent's denial of the parent's application for open enrollment for NiAirea Miller and JaNiyah Miller.

THE HEARING OFFICER'S RECOMMENDATION IS:

"The Board of Education should approve the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as prepared by the Hearing Officer after the Open Enrollment Appeal Hearing of the parent of NiAirea Miller and JaNiyah Miller as attached and uphold the denial of the open enrollment request for these students in this case as shown in the attached Exhibit A, Proposed Findings of Fact of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

BACKGROUND:

Medicaid is a federal/state cost sharing benefit program for health and medically necessary services for low-income individuals that was established as Title XIX of the Social Security Act in 1965. Originally, Medicaid benefits could not be used for services provided under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA). In 1988, the Medicare Catastrophic Coverage Act allowed Medicaid to pay for covered medical services provided to Medicaid-enrolled children with special health care needs on their individualized education program (IEP) or individual family service plan (IFSP).

Within the Iowa Department of Education, there are three aspects to reimbursement from the Iowa Medical Assistant Program (Medicaid). A Local Education Agency (LEA) is a community school district that is able to seek reimbursement for services provided to children requiring special education with services identified on an IEP. An Area Education Agency (AEA) is a regional service center able to seek reimbursement for services provided to children requiring special education. The Early ACCESS Program also allows reimbursement for services to children from birth to age three with at least a 25% developmental delay and services identified on an IFSP.

The process of identification, documentation and submission of qualifying services follows strict guidelines. School districts contract with specialized service companies to assist and maximize the level of reimbursement possible. The Waterloo District has greatly expanded the utilization of Medicaid reimbursements in the last 9 years. The district requested proposals from the companies that work within Iowa, Timberline Billing Service of Clive, IA, and M.J. Care of Milwaukee, WI.

Michael Coughlin, Chief Financial Officer, recommends the following company for continuation of the Medicaid Billing Services for the Waterloo Community Schools: Timberline Billing Service.

- 1) Waterloo has a relationship with Timberline Billing service and with this partnership Waterloo Schools has increased the billing total from \$500,000 with the previous company to over \$3,900,000 with Timberline Billing Service. We anticipate this amount to increase with the continuation of coordination with Timberline Billing Service.
- 2) Currently Central Rivers AEA has Timberline Billing Service as a client. Waterloo coordinates billing for student needs at the school of River Hills and other AEA programs. Continuing with Timberline Billing Service would allow continued seamless coordination with these schools as they currently assist in preparation of paperwork and submission of claims directly to Timberline Service.
- 3) Timberline Billing Service has submitted a three year proposal at 6% which allows for an expected fee in regards to budgeting. M.J. Care quote has a slight decrease in percentage (1%) of net federal funds for one year, but it is unknown of future fees as their rates have previously been higher.

- 4) TBS in the past has offered college scholarships for students with IEPs after they graduate. Waterloo appreciates the stewardship this communicates to families. Student Applicants must be from a Timberline Billing Service client district.
- 5) Adding the ADDENDUM: additional responsibilities will identify and notify district of eligible students to increase Medicaid claiming, monitor IEP/BIP/IHP for services that can be claimed and notify district staff of any changes, amongst other services listed in the attached addendum. The increased services will increase the Medicaid revenue.

THE SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION IS:

"the Board of Education accept the recommendation and approve the renewal of the contract from Timberline Billing Services of claims as presented from July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019."

Agreement to Joint Representation/Waiver of Potential Conflict of Interest

BACKGROUND:

Multiple school districts in the state of Iowa, including Waterloo, have been named in an IDEA (Individuals with Disabilities Education Act) State Complaint filed with the Iowa Department of Education. The complaint alleges that each respective school district has violated the IDEA based on its use of physical restraint and seclusion. The complaints do not allege any child-specific facts that would constitute a violation of the IDEA; instead the complaints rely entirely on the school district's respective data submissions to the U.S. Department of Education's Office for Civil Rights. These data submissions are part of an annual reporting process to the Department of Education.

Because so many districts were named, the complaints have been turned over to Ahlers & Cooney of Des Moines for joint representation. The agreement for joint representation requires board approval.

THE SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION IS:

"the Board of Education approve the Agreement to Joint Representation and Waiver of Potential Conflict of Interest with Ahlers & Cooney, P.C., of Des Moines."

BACKGROUND:

The Iowa Association of School Boards (IASB) requests from each member district its top legislative priorities. Our district can submit up to four legislative priorities.

It is recommended that the Waterloo School Board consider, at a minimum, these priorities:

- 1) **Resolution #5 English Learners:** Supports sufficient and on-time funding for English-learners (EL) until the students reach proficiency.
- 2) **Resolution** #6 **Dropout/At Risk:** Supports the inclusion of dropout prevention and funding for at-risk students in the foundation formula and the inclusion of socio-economic status as a factor in determining a student's at-risk status. Opposes changes to the compulsory age of attendance unless sufficient funds are provided to implement strategies to retain those students.
- 3) **Resolution #7 Mental Health:** Supports increased statewide access to and funding for mental health services for children.
- 4) **Resolution #27 SAVE (Secure an Advanced Vision for Education):** Supports repeal of the December 31, 2029 sunset on the statewide penny sales tax for school infrastructure. Supports preserving the integrity of the statewide penny sales tax for school infrastructure including the tax equity provisions in the following manner:
 - No diversions or expansions of allowable uses prior to the current 2029 sunset date;
 - Continued growth in the per pupil amount beyond the 2029 sunset date.

Discussion at the Board meeting may alter the list of priorities; the following suggested motion would be adapted accordingly.
