BACKGROUND:

The Board of Education established the Swartzendruber Award for Academic Excellence in June 2002, to recognize improvement in academic achievement. It is named in honor of former Superintendent, Dr. Arlis Swartzendruber.

Dr. Swartzendruber led our District from 1995-2002 through some difficult financial times, getting us back on our feet and moving ahead to increase student achievement. During his tenure, the District began to reverse a years-long trend of declining achievement. The Board wanted to honor his legacy with this annual award.

The award includes a traveling trophy to be displayed in a place of honor at the winning school, as well as a plaque that will permanently recognize each school that has received the award and the year it was received. In the event of a tie, which we have had twice, the award is shared equally, with each winning school displaying the trophy for half of the school year.

While the recipient may or may not have the highest achievement scores in the district, it has demonstrated the largest percent gain in standardized test scores for the past year. That growth is what we wanted to celebrate.

BACKGROUND:

ASBO Award: The Association of School Business Officials International (ASBO) has awarded the Waterloo Community School District the Certificate of Excellence in Financial Reporting for 2016-17. This award was recommended by the association's panel of review which judged that the Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR) substantially conforms to principles and standards of ASBO's Certificate of Excellence Program and the Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB).

<u>GFOA Award</u>: The Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting has been awarded to the Waterloo Community School District by the Governmental Financial Officers Association of the United States and Canada (GFOA) for its 2016-17 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR). The Certificate of Achievement is the highest form of recognition in the area of governmental accounting and financial reporting and its attainment represents a significant accomplishment by a government and its management.

An Award of Financial Reporting Achievement has been awarded to the individual(s), department or agency designated by the government as primarily responsible for preparing the award winning CAFR. This has been presented to Michael Coughlin, Chief Financial Officer and the entire Business Office Staff. This is the 21st consecutive year these awards have been received by the Waterloo Community School District.

The CAFR has been judged by an impartial panel to meet the high standards of the program including demonstrating a constructive "spirit of full disclosure" to clearly communicate the financial story and motivate potential users and user groups to read the CAFR.

The GFOA is a nonprofit professional association serving approximately 15,000 government finance professionals with offices in Chicago, IL and Washington, D.C.

ISSUE: Contract with Hawkeye Community College for Driver's Education

BACKGROUND:

The District began contracting driver education in the 1996-97 school year and has continued throughout the current school year. Since the first year of contracted services, there has been a significant reduction in district cost associated with the program as compared to operating inhouse. The contractor assumes all the program-related costs, including staff expenses.

The district net cost for driver education during the past three years is outlined below. District expenses were directed to the payment of costs for students qualifying for student fee waiver.

2015-16 \$101,458 2016-17 \$98,748 2017-18 \$84,326

The student fees charged during the past three years are summarized below. The district pays from 40% to 100% of the fee for students that qualify for fee waiver.

•	2015-16	\$334	\$201 (reduced fee)
•	2016-17	\$344	\$207 (reduced fee)
•	2017-18	\$344	\$207 (reduced fee)

The current Request for Proposal was distributed to prospective contractors for the Driver Education program. The District received notification from Street Smarts, the current contractor that due to shortage of staff, were unable to offer services to all students. They suggested working with another local contractor, Goulden Rule of Cedar Falls to share the program. In addition, classes would be held after school, not during the regular day. Street Smarts is offering the classes, with the help of Goulden Rule staff and is agreeing to a one-year contract.

• 2018-19 \$365/student \$219 (reduced fee)

After the approval of the Street Smarts contract, Hawkeye Community College has introduced the class to provide driver's education to Waterloo High School Students. Street Smarts expressed limitation to provide enough staff to meet the needs of all the students.
