

APPLICATION FOR REMISSION OF TUITION (TUITION NOT REQUIRED)

Students who live within the school district with someone other than a parent or guardian may attend the Waterloo Community Schools without paying tuition if the primary purpose for being in the district is other than to attend a free public school in the Waterloo Community School District. Guardianship is not required.

A responsible adult (the adult with whom the student will be residing) shall complete the "Remission of Tuition" application and provide it to the District Registrar, who will determine eligibility for tuition-free attendance. The adult must indicate the reason and duration of the residence of the student in the District and a local contact for the supervision of the child.

If eligible to be a tuition-free student, the student can be counted on the District's certified enrollment at the next Official Count Day. If tuition is required, the parent/guardian will be referred to the Financial Services Office to arrange for payment.

The Board may waive tuition requirements in hardship cases for otherwise ineligible students, but this does not allow the district to include the students in its official count.

The original of the approved Remission of Tuition Application will be filed with the District Registrar.
