TOBACCO/NICOTINE PRODUCTS-FREE ENVIRONMENT

School district property (owned or leased) including facilities, school buildings, vehicles, stadiums and parking lots shall be off limits for use of tobacco or nicotine use, including the use of look-a-likes, like vaping where the original would include tobacco or nicotine and nicotine products that are not FDA (Federal Drug Administration) approved for tobacco cessation. The use of any electronic device that can be used to deliver nicotine and/or other controlled substances to the person inhaling from the device also is prohibited. These devices are referred to as ENDS (Electronic Nicotine Delivery Systems) by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA). Possession of other products such as pods or other components that may be sold separately from the actual devices but permit use whether by holding liquid, charging the ENDS or performing some other function. SAI, 2018. This requirement extends to students, employees, and visitors. This policy applies at all times, including school-sponsored and non-school-sponsored events. Persons failing to abide by this request shall be required to extinguish their smoking material, dispose of the tobacco, nicotine, or other product, or leave the school district premises immediately. It shall be the responsibility of the administration to enforce this policy.

The use and possession of tobacco/nicotine products by students is addressed in policy 504.1, *Drug-Free School Environment*.
