**Parking Lot:**

**Our goal is to have a smooth running system that works for everyone. In order for this to be possible we ask for your cooperation.**

**As you enter the parking lot it is best to think of "the loop" as two lanes. The outside lane (the right lane next to the sidewalk) is where we would like students to be dropped off/picked up.**

- 1. Please pull as far forward as possible when you enter this lane. This helps keep traffic moving and avoids unneeded bottlenecks.**
- 2. After your student(s) has exited/entered the vehicle we ask that you cautiously pull into the left lane and proceed to the parking lot exit.**
- 3. During the afternoon pick up period, please stay to the left and continue looping through the lot if there is no space along the curb. We would like to avoid having students running/walking between cars and also want there to be a continuous flow in that left lane. Staff will assist you as needed.**

4. If you must park for any time please use the marked parking spaces. Again, this helps to keep traffic moving.
5. Please do not park along the curb where it is painted red. This area allows traffic to move toward the exit in an organized fashion.

Thank you for your cooperation. Please remember, if we all work together (synergize) we should be able to meet our student and family needs.

#### **Blue Zones Reminder**

Our school is a designated Blue Zone School. During the month that your child is celebrating a birthday, he/she will be recognized by participating in a special activity and will receive a pencil.
