

BOARD MEMBER RESIGNATION

The Board of Education believes that any citizen who seeks election to the Board shall do so with the full knowledge of the investment of time, effort, and dedication expected of a good Board member and that the citizen's intent to serve reflects his or her intention to serve a full term.

However, if for reasons of health, change in residence, or any other compelling reason a member decides to terminate service, the Board requests earliest possible notification of intent to resign so that the Board may plan appropriately for the vacancy.
