

PROBATION

The Board of Education of the Waterloo Community School District believes that one form of disciplinary action is the placement of students on probationary status. This action will be at the discretion of the building administrator or his/her designee or the Board.

Due process will be afforded to all individuals concerned.

Probation means a student is given a conditional suspension of a penalty for a definite period of time in addition to being reprimanded. The conditional suspension will mean the student must meet the conditions and terms for the suspension of the penalty. Failure of the student to meet these conditions and terms will result in immediate reinstatement of the penalty.
