COMPETENT PRIVATE INSTRUCTION GRADUATION FOR THE HOME SCHOOLED

PURPOSE

To ensure that home schooled students who graduate from the Waterloo Community School District have at least the equivalent of the minimum education required of those who attend on a full-time basis. The minimum credits required to receive a Core Diploma is 34-43 credits

Families Residing Within the District

This section is for families who reside in the Waterloo School District and want their student to receive a diploma from the Waterloo Community Schools.

Credits Toward Graduation

To receive high school credits, it is suggested to enroll in high school courses starting in 9th grade.

Students taking correspondence courses through a pre-approved accredited institution will be given credit toward graduation if the accredited institution indicates the student passes the course(s). The Office of Teaching & Learning evaluates each course for standards alignment and possible credits toward a diploma.
