

STUDENT GUIDANCE AND COUNSELING PROGRAM

The Board will provide a student guidance and counseling program. School counselors shall be certified with the Board of Educational Examiners and hold the qualifications required by the Board. The guidance and counseling program will serve grades kindergarten through twelve. The program will assist students with their personal, educational, and career development. These services include assistance with (1) planning and scheduling a program of studies, (2) home/school/social concerns, (3) college planning, (4) occupation and career information, (5) interpretation of test information, (6) crisis management, and (7) work with families. The program is coordinated with the education program and involves licensed employees. Parents are encouraged to contact their child's school guidance office with any questions or concerns.
