### Multiple Measure Assessment

Additional options to the proficiency requirement were established as a means for students who may not do well on tests or do not have scores from the ISASP but are able to demonstrate subject proficiency through grades, GPA, and other measures of college readiness. (*Senior Year Plus, 2024*)

If a student reaches a range of 4 points or higher per subject, eligibility for liberal arts concurrent options is met.
