

## EDUCATIONAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR BUILDING

Prior to any major construction project, educational specifications shall be reviewed by the Superintendent and District personnel. The Board shall periodically review and approve these educational specifications.

The educational specifications will be used by the architect in planning the building elements so the structure will facilitate teaching and learning. The educational specifications should include the financial resources available for the project; as well as the following:

- provide an inventory of program requirements
- a statement of space relationships
- a definition of the number and character of classrooms
- a description of such areas as the media center
- special needs area
- use of technology
- outside site activities
- gymnasium
- cafeteria
- auditorium
- administrative offices
- teacher and student service facilities
- public service or community service facilities and any other pertinent information which will be of significance in visualizing what is expected of the proposed new building, building addition, or renovation.
