

BUILDINGS AND SITES ADAPTATION FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

The Board recognizes the need for access to its buildings and sites by persons with disabilities. School district buildings and sites currently in use will be altered to be accessible to persons with disabilities unless the alteration would cause an undue hardship for the school district. When alteration of buildings and sites cause an undue hardship for the school district, the program or service will be made available in an alternative accessible site. Renovated and new buildings and sites shall be accessible to persons with disabilities.

It is the responsibility of the superintendent, upon board approval, to take the necessary action to ensure school district buildings and sites are accessible to persons with disabilities.
