

PUBLIC SOLICITATIONS IN THE SCHOOLS

Since the primary purpose of the Waterloo Schools is education, the Board of Education discourages the use of students for the collection of funds or for the sale of items not directly related to the educational program or a school-sponsored activity.

Proposals for general solicitation by students must be presented to the Superintendent or designee for approval on an individual basis.

It is not the intent of this policy to curtail cooperation between the public schools and community agencies in activities of an educational nature. The voluntary participation of students in such activities is desirable and should be encouraged.
