



Expo Alternative Learning Center Student Lighthouse Team Application

Expo Alternative's Student Lighthouse Team members are to understand and practice the 7 Habits of Highly Effective Teens. Members will work closely with the Staff Lighthouse Team and make a positive impact for EALC students, staff, families, and community. Members will help plan leadership events and leadership opportunities throughout the school year.

Expo Alternative Learning Center's Student Lighthouse Team members must consistently demonstrate the following leadership characteristics:

- 1) Dependability, reliability, and respect
- 2) Completes classwork and homework assignments
- 3) Pass assigned courses
 - a. Student Lighthouse members who fail a course(s) and/or fail to complete a course within the designated time frame will meet with a Lighthouse Panel with at least two Lighthouse Staff members and at least two Student Lighthouse members to develop a plan for improving grades and/or course completion
- 4) Strong work ethic
- 5) Exemplary conduct and citizenship in and out of school
 - a. Lighthouse Students who receive a minor referral will meet and discuss behavioral expectations with at least two Lighthouse Staff members and at least two Student Lighthouse members to review the Student Lighthouse contract and behavioral expectations
 - b. Lighthouse Students who receive their first major will meet and discuss the major referral with at least two Lighthouse Staff members and at least two Student Lighthouse members to determine next steps:
 - i. Suspension for the Student Lighthouse Team for a time period to be determined by Lighthouse Staff and Student Panel
 - ii. Restitution
 - iii. No action taken
 - c. Lighthouse Students who receive their second major will be dropped from the Student Lighthouse Team
- 6) Excellent attendance (on time with limited absences)
 - a. Student Lighthouse members who have attendance issues will meet with at least two Lighthouse Staff members and at least two Student Lighthouse members to develop a plan for improving attendance/tardies
- 7) Good judgment and decision making skills
- 8) Comfortable with public speaking
- 9) Ability to teach and demonstrate the 7 Habits to students and staff
