# What Can You Do to Help Your Child Demonstrate PAWS Behavior?

- √ Review PAWS expectations with your child. Everyday ask your child about his/her day at school.
- √ Make sure your child is ready every day. Ensure a good night's sleep.
- √ Provide a quiet time and space for your child to do homework nightly.
- √ Keep in touch with your child's teacher(s).
- $\checkmark$  Encourage your child to use appropriate language and tone.
- √ Practice positive phrases with your child, such as, "Thank you," "Excuse me," "Please," and "I'm sorry."
- Be a visible part of your child's school day. Attend PTO meetings, Parent Teacher Conferences, and other school activities as your schedule allows.
