What is PBIS at school?

We use a set of expectations in our building, on the playground and on the bus. The expectations are posted throughout our school. Students are taught the PAWS expectation during “Lincoln University” at the beginning of the year, after Christmas break and whenever necessary.

PAWS expectations are:

Positive Attitude
Always Respectful
Work Hard
Stay Safe

What Can You Do to Help Your Child Demonstrate PAWS Behavior?

- √ Review PAWS expectations with your child. Everyday ask your child about his/her day at school.
- √ Make sure your child is ready every day. Ensure a good night’s sleep.
- √ Provide a quiet time and space for your child to do homework nightly.
- √ Keep in touch with your child’s teacher(s).
- √ Encourage your child to use appropriate language and tone.
- √ Practice positive phrases with your child, such as, “Thank you,” “Excuse me,” “Please,” and “I’m sorry.”
- √ Be a visible part of your child’s school day. Attend PTO meetings, Parent Teacher Conferences, and other school activities as your schedule allows.

- ✓ Have a positive attitude
- ✓ Listen to others


Safe

- ✓ Follow directions
- ✓ Be kind (treat others the way you would like to be treated)
- ✓ Care for our school building and use school supplies appropriately

PAWS tickets are a recognition system used to acknowledge students who demonstrate PAWS expectations. Our goal is to recognize all students following the expectations, as well as those going above and beyond, during each school day.
